1. H-1B Specialty Worker visas are for U.S. employers to employ foreign nationals in specialized occupations which require at least a Bachelor's degree or equivalent experience.
2. Family members may join the H-1B Specialty Worker to the U.S. in H-4 status.
3. Non-spouse partner (regardless of gender) of temporary work visa holders may join them in the U.S., depending on the criteria.
